

PRC rejects Calls to Curb North Korea

The Chosun Ilbo is reporting (http://english.chosun.com/site/data/html_dir/2010/12/10/2010121000651.html) that the People's Republic of China has rejected calls to convince North Korea to start acting responsibly.

“A Chinese envoy on Thursday rejected calls for Beijing to curb North Korea made by the foreign ministers of South Korea, the U.S. and Japan earlier this week after the North's artillery attack on Yeongpyeong Island. Chinese Ambassador to Japan Cheng Yonghua said, **"It's unreasonable for South Korea, the U.S. and Japan to ask China to use its influence over the North."** (Bold mine.)

Cheng was speaking with the Asahi Shimbun on Thursday. If the three countries "have anything to demand of the North, they should hold direct dialogue with the country," instead of China, he said. "Dialogue is the only way unless they want to aggravate the situation."

"China does not interfere in internal affairs of other countries. That means we will say what needs to be said to our ally [North Korea] but will never interfere in its internal affairs," he added.”
